Faculty of Veterinary Medicine

It was founded in 1950 and since 2004 it has been included in the list of approved European Veterinary schools (E.A.E.V.E.)

During its sixty years of operation, awarded more than 3,500 Veterinary Degrees, 60 Master's Degrees and 300 Doctorate Degrees.

Furthermore, it has awarded the title of Honorary Doctorate to 10 foreign veterinary scientists, who contributed worldwide to the advancement of Veterinary Science and/or significantly helped the Department of Veterinary Medicine of A.U.Th.

It offers the opportunity to become a specialist in various scientific fields like anaesthesia and analgesia, food science etc.

Companion Animal Clinic

Each year the Companion Animal Clinic, which consists of all clinical specialties and subspecialties such as dermatology and pulmonology, receives approximately 3,500 cases, including some equine cases. These cases come from all over Greece, as the clinic is a reference center for difficult cases. The Companion Animal Clinic operates the emergency room, an intensive care unit, and there is also a morgue, where, among other things, autopsies are performed for animals that have been killed or poisoned.

Necropsy Unit

The necropsy unit handles multiple cases on a daily basis, involving animals that have either died within the clinic of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki or have been submitted already deceased by their owners or law enforcement for post-mortem examination. Post-mortem examinations are conducted by students under the guidance of the professor. These assessments are carried out on a wide range of animals, including pets, farm animals, and wildlife.

Farm Animal Clinic

Pathology cases

Primarily pulmonary and digestive problems caused by bacteria, viruses, parasites or inadequate management

Surgical cases

umbilical hernia, foot pathology, intestinal hernia, umbilitis, etc

The Reproductive System

Infertility incidents, high abortion rates in livestock units, teat strictures, damaged teats and udders, mastitis

Obstetric incidents

dystocia, caesarean sections, embryotomies, prolapse of the uterus, uterine torsion, aerovagina, etc

Hygiene of animal-derived foods

In the unit of hygiene of foods of animal origin, various tests are carried out on food suspected of contamination by pathogenic or spoilage microorganisms. Such examinations are microbiological tests and chemical analyses, primarily on meat and milk products. Moreover, students participate in visits to slaughterhouses and food processing facilities.
